

PUBLIC NOTICE

Senior Citizen Water & Sewer Rates

Annual renewal period begins October 1st and runs through October 31st. Failure to appear will result in the Senior Citizen Water and Sewer Rates being removed from the account. The bill must be in the name of the Senior Citizen.

As of October 1, 2017, citizens of the City of Carrizo Springs who are 65 years of age or older are eligible to receive Senior Citizen Rates on water and sewer services. If you are 62 years of age or older and were a member of the program in FY 2016-2017, you are grandfathered and will remain in the program.

It is important to note that those who are currently signed up for the program are required to sign up for this service every year.

Citizens turning 65 in FY 2017-2018, will be eligible to submit their application the day they turn 65. However, the application will not impact the bill until the billing period after the submission date. Thus, if you turn 65 on February 25, 2018 you would come to City Hall and file your application in March, 2018. The applicant must appear in person; show a valid picture ID, provide records and documents that the applicant owns, rents and resides within the city limits of the City of Carrizo Springs. Application forms are available at City Hall.
